BOLOGNA

Capital of the metropolitan city and of the Emilia Romagna region, Bologna is located between the mountains of the Tuscan-Emilian Apennines and the heart of the Po Valley.

As a city with an international feel, rich in art, culture and commerce, with an efficient trade fair facility and a renowned manufacturing and motoring tradition, home to the first university in the Western world, Bologna welcomes everyone, tempting them with its good life, good art and good food.

Discovering Bologna means finding yourself in a city with centuries-old tradition, testified by the prominent presence of architecture of different styles and eras. At the foot of the famous hills, dotted with many medieval gates and towers, the historic centre of the city truly offers a warm embrace to its guests. Proof of this are both the magnificent porticoes that wind for over 38 km in the centre alone, part of which has been recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and the suggestive Piazza Maggiore, an open-air city lounge.

Bologna, nicknamed “la Grassa”, is synonymous with food and wine. Mortadella, “ragù alla Bolognese”, tortellini, lasagne, tagliatelle, boiled meat, Certosino, are just some of the products that have made Bologna famous in the world together with the legendary sfogline, whose cooking classes are attended by visitors from every continent.

You Cannot Miss This: a stop to taste “la spianata con la mortadella”.

PARMA

Located in the northern area of the Emilia-Romagna region, Parma is not only a city of culture, theatre and music, but also a UNESCO Creative City for gastronomy in Italy and the capital of the Food Valley, where products of Italian excellence in the world originate: Parma ham and Parmigiano Reggiano, just to name a few.

The first stop of the visit must include the Duomo. Located in one of the most beautiful squares in Italy, it is considered a wonderful example of Lombard Romanesque architecture and preserves Renaissance works of great value. Next to the Cathedral stands the Baptistery of Parma, another symbolic place of the city, entirely covered in pink marble and embellished with paintings and frescoes. Teatro Farnese in Parma deserves an in-depth visit, as it is an incredible example of inventiveness.

You Cannot Miss This: a guided tour and tasting in a “prosciuttificio”, to discover the production of Parma Ham, that after twelve months of air curing earns the fire brand, the ducal crown that certifies the DOP.



MODENA

Located in the heart of Emilia-Romagna, a city of art, land of motors and taste, Modena is full of charm. The visit to the city must include the 3 architectural works that became UNESCO World Heritage Sites in 1997: il Duomo; The Civic Tower, known simply as Ghirlandina, the bell tower of the Cathedral and the true symbol of Modena; Piazza Grande and Galleria Estense.

Enzo Ferrari's birthplace, Modena is in fact a place where the passion for mechanics has a long tradition and the myth of speed is an integral part of its culture.

Modena is also the birthplace of Luciano Pavarotti, listed among the greatest tenors of all time. It's possible to visit "Casa Museo Pavarotti", to gently approach his memory and admire his private world. Among the culinary specialties of Modena there are unique products such as Balsamic Vinegar PDO and PGI, Lambrusco, Modena Ham and Tortellini.

You Cannot Miss This: try the semi-professional simulators in Ferrari Museum in Maranello, in order to experience the thrill of driving a Ferrari Formula 1.

FERRARA

Ancient capital of the Duchy of Este, it is an unmissable stop for all those who love art, culture, nature and good food. Located in the Emilian plain, the city stands a few kilometres south of the Po River, about 50 km from the sea.

The Este family governed it for three centuries and gave it the appearance it still retains today: a unique urban planning that harmoniously blends the Middle Ages and the Renaissance and makes it the first modern city in Europe. Precisely for this characteristic, it has been recognized by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site.

Mandatory stops on a visit to the city include: Palazzo dei Diamanti, Castello Estense, a walk along the suggestive medieval streets and along "Le Mura" of the city.

Talking about Ferrara's culinary specialties, we must mention "la coppia", the tasty bread with an elaborate shape, awarded the IGP mark; the "cappellacci" and "la salama da sugo", an unusual mix of pork meats.

You Cannot Miss This: a lunch in one of the typical restaurants of the narrow alleys of the centre, must try "la salama da sugo" accompanied by the mash potatoes.

DELTA DEL PO

The Po Delta Park is one of the most important wetlands in Europe and the largest in Italy, hosting hundreds of animal and plant species. It covers a very important part of the territory of Regione Emilia-Romagna.

In 1999, the Ferrara part of the Po Delta was included in the list of World Heritage Sites as an "exceptional planned cultural landscape which remarkably retains its original form".



On foot, by boat, bike, train or on horseback, you can discover wonders between land and sea. From Goro to Mesola and Comacchio, from Ravenna to Cervia, hundreds of itineraries are available to enjoy nature at a slow pace; visitors will also find workshops, guided visits, birdwatching experiences, sports events and much more.

You Cannot Miss This: a boat trip to the Comacchio valleys, to admire an ecosystem of extraordinary beauty, the kingdom of flamingos and eels.

RAVENNA

Ravenna: the city of mosaics and Dante Alighieri! Nestled a few kilometres from the Adriatic Sea, and suspended in the heart of Romagna, Ravenna is a treasure chest of art, history and culture with an ancient and glorious past behind it.

In Ravenna there are eight buildings declared by UNESCO as world heritage sites. Mosaic art found its widest expression in Ravenna. The Mausoleum of Galla Placidia, the Neonian and Arian Baptisteries, the Basilica of Sant'Apollinare Nuovo and Sant'Apollinare in Classe, the Archiepiscopal Chapel of Sant'Andrea, the Basilica of San Vitale and the Mausoleum of Theodoric are symbols of Ravenna's glorious past that you will hardly forget. Ravenna also houses the remains of the Father of Italian Literature, Dante Alighieri, and keeps his memory alive with important events all around the year. For nature and hiking lovers, it is possible to immerse yourself in the naturalistic beauties of the Po Delta Park, where rare species of birds find refuge.

The art of eating well in Ravenna has solid roots that sink into the typical peasant knowledge of Romagna: Piadina romagnola, cappelletti with ragù, passatelli in brodo, caramelized figs with squacquerone are some of the typical dishes of the city, without forgetting a good glass of Sangiovese Superiore.

You Cannot Miss This: a visit to Mercato Coperto, to shop, eat or just take a tour.

FAENZA

Cut in two by the Via Emilia and crossed by the path of the Lamone river, Faenza is a city of art of Roman origins with a marked Renaissance appearance, which does not disdain to show clear references to the splendor of the Baroque and the bourgeois elegance of the Art Nouveau.

Its name is famous beyond the borders of Italy for the production of ceramics and as the city that hosts, within the MIC – The International Museum of Ceramics, the most extensive existing typological collection dedicated to this ancient art.

The area is rich in high-quality products such as the Peach of Romagna and the Nectarine PGI, apricots and grapes. DOC wines range from Sangiovese, to Trebbiano, from Pagadebit to the famous Cagnina dolce, to the appreciated Albana DOCG in the dry and passito versions; traditional first courses of hand-rolled pasta and passatelli in broth.

You Cannot Miss This: a typical tasting on the Strada della Romagna - Strada dei Vini e dei Sapori delle Colline di Faenza.



RIMINI

“La dolce vita” in Rimini has been living for over 160 years in the memories and dreams of generations of vacationers. The secret of its success is its friendliness, hospitality and a territory famous for its 15 km of beach, 230 colourful bathing establishments, over 1000 hotels and amusement parks, but also for its 2000 years of history and a small treasure chest of art.

The traces that over two centuries of history and culture have left in the city are translated into true symbols of the city. The Malatesta Temple is a Renaissance masterpiece that includes works by Piero della Francesca and Matteo de' Pasti. The city is home to the oldest preserved arch in northern Italy, the Arch of Augustus. Castel Sismondo is the fortress located in Piazza Malatesta, and today preserves the central nucleus of the original construction with large square towers and mighty walls.

And then: Teatro Galli, Ponte di Tiberio, the ancient neighborhood San Giuliano, the archaeological site of the 'Domus del Chirurgo', that preserves an exceptional surgical-pharmaceutical set, which has reached us intact from the Roman era.

For gourmets, it is recommended to try a real piadina from Rimini. Here, the piadina is thinner and everyone can fill it as they wish: from ham and mozzarella to wild herbs and chocolate cream. Other protagonists of the table are the Adriatic blue fish and the red Sangiovese wine. Travelling along the routes of the Strada dei Vini e dei Sapori dei Colli di Rimini is an excellent way to discover dishes and recipes from the past.

You Cannot Miss This: a ride on the Ferris wheel, to enjoy a panoramic view of the Romagna coast, from Gabicce to Cesenatico, of the hinterland and of the Republic of San Marino.

RICCIONE

Listed among the most renowned seaside resorts on the Adriatic, Riccione is a trendy city where fashion, elegance, a lively atmosphere and the pleasure of life conquer visitors. It is the second most populated municipality in the province after the capital Rimini and since 1990 it has been able to boast the honorary title of city. The heart of the city is Viale Ceccarini, known for being a crossroads of fashions and trends to be discovered among boutiques and clubs. Riccione is perfect for a family holiday, hosting two famous amusement parks: Aquafan and Oltremare, but also a business destination, with its recent Congress Palace.

1ST DAY



RICCIONE/RIMINI AREA

Arrival to Riccione/ Rimini area. Hotel check-in, dinner and overnight.

2ND DAY



RIMINI

Breakfast and departure for guided city tour of Rimini. Famous seaside resort on the Adriatic Coast with its centre which suggests an ancient heart, the tour represents a true journey through centuries of history. Classic half day itinerary includes Ponte di Tiberio, Arco di Augusto, Castel Sismondo, Tempio Malatestiano and Piazza Cavour with Teatro Galli. Free lunch and afternoon. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

3th DAY



BOLOGNA

Breakfast and departure to Bologna. Arrival and guided tour of the historic centre of Bologna: Piazza Maggiore, the Gothic Basilica of S. Petronio, the Palace of King Enzo, the Fountain of Neptune, Palace of Archiginnasio, the two Towers. Free lunch and time for shopping in Bologna. At the end, return to the hotel, dinner and overnight.

4th DAY



FERRARA AND EXCURSION BY BOAT ON COMACCHIO VALLEYS

Breakfast and departure to Ferrara. Arrival and guided visit to the city, a Renaissance jewel and admirable example of harmony. The winding medieval streets and the imposing Renaissance ones are lined with historic buildings, witnesses of the city's history: the Estense Castle, the Cathedral, Palazzo Schifanoia, Palazzo dei Diamanti. At 12.00 departure for Comacchio, arrival and free time for lunch.

After lunch, boarding at Stazione Focce for an excursion by boat on Comacchio Valleys. Accompanied by an environmental guide, you will navigate the ancient bed of the Po river, skirting the former salt pans of Comacchio, the flamingo's nesting site: the colony numbers over 10,000 specimens and during navigation the frequency of sightings is very high. We will stop at the old "fishing huts", where the guide will illustrate the fishing methods, the ancient traditions, the uses and customs of the people of Comacchio. At the end of the visit, return to the hotel, dinner and overnight.

5th DAY



CERVIA INCLUDED SALT MUSEUM AND EXCURSION BY ELECTRIC BOAT TO THE SALT PAN

Breakfast and departure to Cervia. Arrival and guided tour of the Salt Museum in the city centre (MUSA), followed by a transfer (at the expense of the group) to the Visitor Centre, from which we set off on a suggestive excursion to the Cervia salt pan, to discover an uncontaminated and magical natural site.

The guided tour in Salina includes a section on an electric boat. On board a very simple electric boat, with wooden benches, we sail along the surrounding canal of the Salina di Cervia to reach its heart. At the end of the visit, return to the hotel, dinner and overnight.

6th DAY



URBINO*

Breakfast and departure to Urbino. Arrival and guided visit to one of the most important centres of the Italian Renaissance, classified as world heritage by Unesco. Visit of the Ducal Palace of Urbino, which houses the National Gallery of the Marche, with masterpieces dating back to between the fourteenth and seventeenth centuries, visit of the native house of Raffaello, symbolic figure of the Renaissance, defined as the “divine painter” for the refinement and sublimity of his works. At the end of the morning, free lunch. Return to Riccione, free afternoon. Dinner and overnight.

*You can choose the visit to Pesaro or San Marino instead of Urbino on this day.

7th DAY

After breakfast, departure and end of tour.

6 DAYS OF ITINERANT BIKING FROM THE PO DELTA TO RICCIONE



6 DAYS / 5 NIGHTS

1ST DAY

VOLANO - COMACCHIO



Arrival in Volano, meeting with the guide, bikes (e-bikes) pick – up and distribution of informational materials. The cycling route begins in Comacchio, a lagoon town characterized by bridges and canals. After visiting the historic center, you'll reach the Manifattura dei Marinati, an ancient fish factory where eels and other fish from the valley were, and still are, marinated. After crossing the drawbridge, you'll follow the valley's embankment to the Foce Fishing Station, where you'll board the motorboat for a historical and naturalistic excursion into the Comacchio Valleys. The pleasant journey alternates with stops to visit the fishermen's huts, the Coccalino guardhouse, and the ancient fishing stations of Pegoraro and Serilla, and it is enriched by the observation of countless species of aquatic birds. Free lunch. At the end of the excursion, you can continue the itinerary by cycling to the Comacchio Salt Pans, a nesting site for numerous bird species, including the greater flamingo. Afterwards, enjoy dinner at a traditional restaurant featuring eel, a delicious staple of the Comacchio cuisine and the Bassa Ferrarese area. Transfer to a hotel in the surroundings of Comacchio and overnight.

2ND DAY

GORINO FERRARESE



Breakfast and transfer to Gorino Ferrarese. Along the way, you can admire the Canneviè nature reserve, then continue to Mesola, where the Estense Castle of Mesola stands tall. Free lunch. In the afternoon, transfer to Gorino Ferrarese, where the visit continues with a sail along the Po di Goro to reach the point where the river and the sea meet and the Island of Love, where the guardian of the river mouth, the Goro lighthouse, stands. During the sail, you can observe the numerous species of aquatic birds that find their ideal habitat here to live and breed. Stop at the ancient lantern to admire the colors of the sunset. Transfer to the hotel in Goro /surroundings, dinner and overnight.

3th DAY

DAY FERRARA



On the third day, after breakfast, set off to return to Volano, entering the fascinating pine forest. Return of the bicycles and departure by the own bus* to Ferrara. Arrival, free lunch. At 14:00 meeting with the technical guide and bikes pick up. Departure by bike for the "The Walls of Ferrara" itinerary. Nine kilometres that embrace the historic centre of Ferrara and can only be travelled on foot or by bicycle, on the embankment or in the valley below. At the end of the day, bikes drop off, hotel check-in, dinner and overnight.

4th DAY

RAVENNA



Breakfast and departure by the own bus* to Ravenna. Arrival and meeting with the technical guide, bikes/ e-bikes pick-up and start of a flat route to discover the historic centre of Ravenna. A completely flat cycle path that begins in the central Piazza del Popolo and passes through some of the monuments and art sites that have made Ravenna famous worldwide, such as the Basilica of San Vitale, the Neonian Baptistry, and Dante's Tomb.

Stop for free lunch. The route continues south along the right bank of the Fiumi Uniti, then it climbs northeast. After veering through the historic centre, it reaches the Parco di Teodorico and then returns to the starting point.

The Basilica of Sant'Apollinare Nuovo, the Mausoleum of Theodoric, and the Public Gardens are just some of the strategic points along the route. Cycling is the best way to explore and appreciate the city, allowing you to gain a first glimpse of historic Ravenna while also exploring its more naturalistic aspects.

Bikes drop off and transfer to At the Covered Market, where you can stroll among many shops and get advice from our artisans to choose from all the excellences of our territory. Dinner in Mercato Coperto's restaurant, to enjoy an authentic taste experience made of genuine local products. At the end of the day, hotel check-in and overnight.

5th DAY



RICCIONE

Breakfast and departure by the own bus* towards Riccione. Stop to visit the ancient Republic of San Marino. Crossing the streets of the medieval village San Marino City, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, accompanied by an expert guide, you can encounter the most important monuments, places of culture, leisure and shopping. Indeed, at the end of the guided visit, free time for shopping. Transfer to Riccione, hotel check-in, dinner and overnight.

6th DAY



RIMINI – END OF TOUR

Breakfast, check -out and departure by the own bus* to Rimini. Famous seaside resort on the Adriatic Coast with its centre which suggests an ancient heart, the tour represents a true journey through centuries of history. RIMINI

PARMA - MODENA



Breakfast and transfer to a cheese factory in the surroundings of Parma, visit with cheese tasting. At the end, departure to a cured meat factory producing Parma Ham through the Colli Parma area. During the visit of the factory it will be possible to observe the production process of this delicacy, learn about its important history, the standards that must be respected and fully understand the origins of the unique character of Parma Ham: sweetness! At the end, ham tasting. In the afternoon departure for a visit to a "Aceto Balsamico" producer, in the surroundings of Modena. Visit to the ancient vinegar factories and explanation of the production techniques of Traditional Balsamic Vinegar of Modena. At the end of the visit, guided tasting of the Traditional Balsamic Vinegar. Return to the hotel, dinner and overnight.

3th DAY

MUSEO FERRARI – MUSEO LAMBORGHINI



Breakfast and departure to Maranello, to visit the famous Museo Ferrari, an exhibition space of 2500 m2 that tells the history of this great company, and the Ferrari Factory. At the end of the visit it's possible to experience the thrill of "driving" a Ferrari Formula 1 single-seater on some of the most famous circuits in the world (O.R., not included in the quotation). Transfer to the Lamborghini Factory and Museum, with a stop for a free lunch on the way. Arrival and start of the guided tour, with the visit to the cars on display inside the Automobili Lamborghini Museum, during the visit it is possible to enter the entire innovative Urus line. Tour allows to closely understand the functioning of the Lamborghini Manufacture. The Factory tours that start from the Museum make the visit an unforgettable experience to discover the most surprising places of the company. Return to the hotel, dinner and overnight.





ROMAGNA, A HERITAGE OF ANCIENT AND RENAISSANCE ART



4 DAYS / 3 NIGHTS

1ST DAY

RIMINI



Arrival to Riccione/ Rimini area. Hotel check in. Guided tour of the historic centre of Rimini, famous for its beach and entertainment but also rich in testimonies from the Roman and Renaissance periods: the Arch of Augustus, the Malatesta Temple, the Surgeon's Domus, Piazza Cavour and the Tiberius Bridge. Return to the hotel, dinner and overnight.

2ND DAY

RAVENNA



Breakfast and departure to Ravenna, well known all over the world for its historical and artistic beauties. The city preserves the richest heritage of mosaics dating back to between the 5th and 6th centuries AD. Within its splendid early Christian and Byzantine religious buildings, many have been declared World Heritage Site by UNESCO. Meeting with the guide and visit to two of the eight UNESCO monuments of Ravenna: Basilica of San Vitale and Mausoleum of Galla Placidia, the Baptistery and S. Apollinare Nuovo. Passage to Dante's Tomb for the evocative Dante Reading. Lunch at the modern restaurant inside the "Mercato Coperto", a huge commercial space where it's possible to taste and purchase the gastronomic excellences of Romagna, like piadina or local salami. At the end of the visit, return to the hotel. Free time. Dinner and overnight.

3RD DAY

FERRARA - COMACCHIO



Breakfast and departure to Ferrara. Arrival and guided tour starting from the Estense Castle, an ancient military fortress which was the backdrop to the splendour of the Este ducal court. Possibility of climbing the Torre dei Leoni to enjoy the view of the city. Followed by a walking visit to the Cathedral, Palazzo Schifanoia, Palazzo dei Diamanti. Transfer to Comacchio, named "Little Venice". Free lunch and visit. At the end of the visit, return to the hotel. Dinner and overnight.

VERUCCHIO AND DEPARTURE



At the end, transfer to “San Valentino organic farm winery”, in the surrounding hills, in San Martino in Venti. Tour of the farm and wine tasting. In the afternoon, transfer to Rimini. Meet your guide in front of the National Motorcycle Museum and guided visit, then transfer to the centre, for a tour to discover Rimini, which begins with a journey through the wonders of Giotto and the Rimini School of the fourteenth century, admiring the frescoes of the apse of St. Augustine and the Crucifix of the Malatesta Temple. 3TH DAY



DUCATI MUSEUM - BOLOGNA

Breakfast and departure to Bologna, to visit Ducati Borgo Panigale Experience e Museo, Museo and Factory visit*. The Ducati Museum is designed to narrate the company's history through four different itineraries that guide the visitor from its origins to the present day. Along the factory tour, you'll be accompanied by an official guide (in Italian*) who will show you how our motorcycles are created. At the end of the visit, transfer to Bologna centre, light lunch with mortadella IGP tasting, the pride of Bologna. This beloved pink cured meat was created in Bologna during the Renaissance. A light, high-quality mortadella lunch tasting features thinly sliced IGP Bologna mortadella paired with fresh, rustic bread (rosetta, focaccia, or baguette) and simple, complementary ingredients like creamy ricotta, stracciatella, pistachios or rocket). Serve with light, dry white wines, sparkling Pignoletto, or a light red Lambrusco. After lunch, a walk under the Portici of Bologna, an Unesco heritage and guided tour of the historic centre: Piazza Maggiore, the Gothic Basilica of S. Petronio, the Palace of King Enzo, the Fountain of Neptune, Palace of Archiginnasio, the two Towers. Return to the hotel. Dinner and overnight.

4TH DAY



FERRARI MUSEUM MARANELLO – MODENA

Breakfast and departure to Maranello, to visit the famous Museo Ferrari, an exhibition space of 2500 m2 that tells the history of this great company, and the Ferrari Factory. At the end of the visit it's possible to experience the thrill of “driving” a Ferrari Formula 1 single-seater on some of the most famous circuits in the world* (O.R.) At the end of the visit, transfer to Modena and light lunch with typical Modena focaccias, “tigelle”. In the Modena area, tigelle are called “crescentine montanare”. Tigella was and is the name of the old

refractory stone molds used to bake them. Once ready and golden brown, the crescentine can be stuffed with the typical Modenese *cunza*, a mixture of lard, rosemary, and garlic, or they can be served with vegetables, cured meats, and cheeses of your choice, such as Parma ham and *crescenza* cheese. After lunch, guided visit to Modena's centre, starting from the Palazzo Ducale Estense, a Baroque-style residence of the Este family, now home to the Military Academy, to arrive in Piazza Grande - declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site - where Torre Ghirlandina and Duomo are located. We will also visit the historic rooms of the Palazzo Comunale, finally reaching the area of the former Jewish ghetto and the Synagogue, among the largest in Italy. Return to the hotel, dinner and overnight.

5th DAY

ENOGASTRONOMIC TREASURES OF ROMAGNA

Let yourself be enticed by the culinary delights of Romagna!

Our territory offers a wide range of enogastronomic products and unique, genuine and authentic flavours, that fill the menu of each restaurant: “piadina”, a typical specialty of Romagna, first courses of pasta homemade with the rolling pin, various cheese as “squaquerone”, salumi (cold cuts), local meats, the “blue fish” of Adriatico, and let’s not forget the precious variety of extra virgin olive oil and the good wines Sangiovese and Albana.

LA PIADA

Who doesn't know “la piada Romagnola”? It's the most classic of the culinary specialties, that you can easily find in each bar or restaurant on the seaside or in the hinterland, the very emblem of Romagna. Fragrant and genuine, la piadina receives universal appreciation and is able to seduce anyone who tastes it, whether Italian or foreign.

The secret of its success lies in its simplicity and the high quality of the few ingredients used: flour, extra virgin olive oil or lard, water and salt.

In 2014, **Piadina Romagnola became part of the PGI products of the European Union**, a recognition of the cultural and gastronomic importance of this recipe.

EXTRA VIRGIN OLIVE OIL “COLLINE DI ROMAGNA” PDO

The presence of the olive tree, in the territory that has as its reference the first hills near the Adriatic coast, has very deep origins that seem to date back to the Etruscans.

Olive cultivation benefits from particular climatic conditions which, together with appropriate agronomic practices, determine the production of a particularly valuable oil, capable of standing out for its chemical and organoleptic characteristics.


In August 2003, **the extra virgin olive oil “Colline di Romagna” obtained the Dop recognition**. It is characterized by a medium or intense fruity olive odor and with possible sensations of grass, leaf, almond, artichoke and tomato. It's excellent both used raw and for cooking, but generally the first approach for tasting is bruschetta.

SQUACQUERONE DI ROMAGNA PDO CHEESE

“Lo Squaquerone di Romagna” it's a soft cheese, made from whole cow's milk. The traditional one of the past was made during winter, in peasant houses. Nowadays production has reached the level of large-scale distribution and **“Squaquerone di Romagna” obtained the recognition of the PDO for the Romagna and Bologna areas**.

Its name derives from the Romagna dialect “squaquaron” which indicates a high level of wateriness. It comes without a crust or peel and its consistency is very creamy.

You can taste these cheese in many ways, but the most traditional use in cooking is piadina, squacquerone and rocket.



SANGIOVESE WINE

“Sangiovese” is the most important wine in the Romagna tradition, considering that the Sangiovese grape variety is very widespread on a national level and contributes to the production of wines of great strength and flavour, such as, for example, Chianti and Brunello di Montalcino.

Despite this, Sangiovese is Romagnolo in name and in fact and was the first to be recognized among the DOC wines of Romagna. The “Romagna Sangiovese DOC” wine must be obtained from grapes of vineyards having, within the company, the following ampelographic composition: Sangiovese minimum 85%. Other black grape varieties suitable for cultivation in the Emilia Romagna region may be used up to a maximum of 15%. “Romagna Sangiovese DOC” is the symbol of the Romagna Wine Protection Authority. Since 1962, the Consortium has brought together wine cellars, vineyards and wine producers to protect the wines of Romagna. It has always strived to defend wine quality, price stability, and the enhancement of the wines and its territory.

SOGLIANO PIT CHEESE PDO

“Formaggio di Fossa” is a cheese matured in pits dug into sandstone rock, obtained from cow milk and sheep milk, with a rich aroma reminiscent of the undergrowth. The tradition of digging into the earth was introduced during the Middle Ages and soon became an integral part of the peasant civilization of the area between the Rubicone and Marecchia valleys, between Romagna and Marche.

Over the centuries the custom has remained constant and loyal, according to the rules established by the Malatesta codes. To better enjoy the flavour of fossa cheese, it is best to bring it to room temperature for a few hours. The combination with honey enhances its flavour and it is excellent accompanied both by the fruit compote called “savor” - a preparation based on grape must cooked for a long time with various types of fruit - and with fresh or dried fruit.

TRADITIONAL FLAVOURS OF ROMAGNA COOKING

The anthem song of Romagna goes: “Romagna mia, Romagna mia, lontan da te non si può star!” (“My Romagna, my Romagna, one cannot be far from you!).

What better place to learn and share the culture of a territory than at the table tasting typical products? Regional cuisine is able to tell the memory of a people through its traditions and food and wine expressions. The Riviera therefore, from the coast to the hinterland, unfolds a rich menu with multiple flavours. The ruby red of Sangiovese, the typical wine of the Romagna region, the blue of the fish from the Adriatic waters, the gold of the ground wheat, an essential ingredient for piada, these are the basic colours of Romagna cuisine. You can savour the sea in all its culinary forms: grilled (“rustida di pesce”), fried (“fritto misto di paranza”), in risottos and broths (“brodetto, a dish with various types of fish cooked in a stew with tomato and spices).

Romagna is also the kingdom of homemade pasta: cappelletti and cappellacci, passatelli: whether dry or in broth, stuffed or not, the handmade egg pasta represents the region’s calling card.

The best moments of taste come to life outside restaurants, in the streets and in the squares, where people gather around sharing the flavours of this land, during the outdoor events and in each eventing of the summer period, which here in Romagna signs a continuous celebration of the good life and entertainment.

FELLINI MUSEUM – RIMINI

Inserted by the Ministry of Culture among the National Heritage Great National Projects, the Museum spans between Sismondo Castle, Fulgor Palace and Malatesta Square. Designed by Studio Azzurro of Milan with the consultancy of Marco Bertozzi and Anna Villari, it is part of the cultural hub that includes the Galli Theatre, Art Palaces Rimini with the Sculpture Garden, the Fulgor Cinema, the City Museum, the Roman Surgeon's House, the Gambalunga Library, the Tiberius Bridge with the Square on the Water and Porta Galliana, the Francesca da Rimini Arena, the Arch of Augusto, the Malatesta Temple and Porta Montanara.

MUSEO DANTE – RAVENNA

Not far from the Tomb of the Supreme Poet, on the first floor of the former Franciscan convent, **MUSEO DANTE** is a **journey through the works, life and memory of Dante Alighieri**, the father of the Italian language. The museum features several rooms, and offers an **emotional journey across history and images**. It deals with the human adventure and artistic experience of Dante, focusing on the Comedy and its fortune. **A series of relics and objects of great suggestion** make the whole experience even more suggestive. On display, you will find the box in which the friars hid the Poet's remains and the chest in which they were displayed in 1865, after their fortuitous recovery.



LUCIANO PAVAROTTI HOME MUSEUM – MODENA

The Luciano Pavarotti Home Museum is the home that Maestro Pavarotti built in the Modena countryside, in a large estate, where he lived the last years of his life.

It opened to the public in 2015 to firmly ground Maestro's memory to his beloved homeland and to make the man LUCIANO behind the great artist PAVAROTTI better known to the general public. Every inch of this home reflects its owner's vibrant personality. Warm light fills the space, a huge window looking at the sky illuminates the rooms – where you can find photos, paintings and letters from dear friends like Frank Sinatra, Bono and Princess Diana – while the kitchen is yellow like the sun. Opera costumes, one-of-a-kind memorabilia and countless awards pay homage to his illustrious career – but it's the everyday objects that reveal the simple man behind the great artist.

AUTOMOBILI LAMBORGHINI MUSEUM – SANT'AGATA BOLOGNESE (BOLOGNA)

The fascinating history, iconic models and tours of the production lines inside the Automobili Lamborghini Museum reveal 60 years of innovation that are projecting Lamborghini into the future. From the first visionary creations of the genius of Ferruccio Lamborghini, such as the Miura and the Countach, followed by the more recent and exclusive super sports cars like the Huracán Performante, the Aventador SVJ, and the few-offs Centenario, Sesto Elemento and Veneno, to arrive today with the first Lamborghinis with hybrid technology, the Sian and Countach LPI 800-4.

The Automobili Lamborghini Museum offers an interactive experience, also provided by the new driving simulator that amplifies the emotions and discovery of the vehicles on display.

OLTREMARE FAMILY EXPERIENCE PARK

Oltremare is a thematic-naturalistic park that promotes the protection and enhancement of animal species and nature through scientific dissemination and direct contact with animals.

The park offers activities suitable for all ages and numerous educational projects designed for schools. The park is made up of different thematic areas. Pianeta Terra and Darwin Experience are dedicated to the history of the evolution of the Earth and the animal species that populate it, while Pianeta Mare and La Laguna dei Delfini are located in the area linked to the marine environment. Attractions such as Delta, Wallaby, the farm area and the birds of prey focus on the flora and fauna of the mainland. The park also has a large play area dedicated to the little ones, Ulysses Island, where they can move freely on bridges and boats.
